
## Issue #1


## Faculty – Dictate Comments on Your Mobile Device

Want to provide comments for your EPA assessment on your mobile device but don't like texting? Simply select the comment box and, once the keyboard pops up, select the microphone icon and start talking. You'll be able to dictate your comments directly into Elentra!



## **Residents** – Save Assessments with a Pin

You might have noticed the "Pin" tab under your "Tasks & Results" dashboard in Elentra. This is used to highlight assessments of interest for easy reference later on. To add assessments to this section, simply go to the "Assessment" tab and select the pin icon on the assessment you wish to highlight.



Residents – Confirm your Assessor with an Email Address

Not sure if you're selecting the correct assessor? Ever wonder if your assessments are being sent to the correct assessor email address? You can now search for the assessor by their email and see the primary email associated with their account in the assessor drop down list.
