All Users – Welcome to the updated version of Elentra for 2019/20!

Existing Elentra users will notice a few changes in the way you initiate and select assessments. New users should find the platform intuitive and easy to use. Improved features are highlighted below.

- Selecting and previewing an EPA in advance of triggering an assessment for CBD programs (see below for details)
- Quick Start an assessment directly from a Learner Dashboard
- Display of an assessor's email alongside name for easy identification

Faculty and Residents – Initiating Assessments

Based on the feedback we received over the last year, we've made it easier for learners and faculty to trigger EPA assessments and to review the detail of an EPA and associated milestones before an assessment is triggered. You can now select the specific EPA assessment you'd like to complete. EPAs can also be filtered by the current stage of training. More details can be found <u>here</u>.
